The UNESCO Chair on Studies in Bioethics and the Iranian National Commission for UNESCO organized a **webinar on Artificial Intelligence (AI) and its ethical considerations in health systems**, on June 17, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. (Tehran time).

Advances in health technologies require an advanced approach to emerging ethical challenges that are complicated by scientific developments. Since the UNESCO document on AI titled "Recommendation on the Ethics of AI" was recently developed, there may be some conflicts that need to be further explained and clarified. Moreover, the document, to be further popularized and implemented, should be further discussed by experts; while cultural differences should not be ignored. In this webinar, the documents were presented by UNESCO experts, followed by Iranian scholars who discussed them from their cultural perspective. This webinar allowed a more powerful implementation of the document as well as its popularization.

UNESCO Chair on Studies in Bioethics, Medical Ethics and History of Medicine Research Center (MEHMRC) at Tehran University of Medical Sciences was established in 2022. MEHMRC has been a pioneer in biomedical ethics since 2005 and has achieved its goals in education, research, and service delivery in biomedical ethics.
